



Code of Conduct

General Statement

A good reputation enables members to take pride in their organization. HOSA members have an excellent reputation. Your conduct at any HOSA function should make a positive contribution to the reputation that has been established. Failure to follow the code of conduct outlined below can result in dismissal from attending Colorado HOSA event and right to membership.

Code of Conduct Explanation

1. Student behavior at all times should be such that it reflects credit to the student, the student school/college, Colorado and National HOSA.
2. Student conduct is the responsibility of the individual and the local chapter advisor. Students shall keep their advisors informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times. (HOSA Conference name badges shall be worn at all times at HOSA functions.)
3. Students are expected to attend all general sessions and other scheduled conference activities. Please be prompt and show respect to those in the audience and on stage.
4. Students are to report any incidents, accidents, injuries or illnesses to their local advisor immediately.
5. Students are expected to observe the designated curfew. (Curfew means being in your own room by the designated hour.)
6. If a student is responsible for stealing, vandalism, or things of that nature - the student and his/her guardians/parents will be responsible for the consequences of all damages.
7. Students and Advisors attending the Fall or State Leadership Conference may not purchase, consume or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to stringent disciplinary action.
8. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas for those of legal age. No smoking inside.
9. Students who disregard the rules of Colorado HOSA, the visiting site, or the school's will be subject to disciplinary action and will be sent home immediately.
10. Any long distance phone calls, charges to the room, etc. will be the responsibility of the individual, guardian, or school.
11. Members are to abide by the Colorado HOSA Dress Policy at all business sessions, general sessions, competitive events and other Conference activities.
12. As a delegate to the State Leadership Conference, permission is granted through the Multiple Release Form to make photographs, videotapes, broadcasts, and/or sound recordings, separately or in combination, be available for reproduction for educational and promotional purposes for Colorado or National HOSA.
