



# COLORADO PIN COMPETITION

---

**Purpose:** To encourage Health Science students to create a pin design depicting Colorado HOSA.

**Description of Event:** This event involves a HOSA member designing a pin depicting Colorado and HOSA. The selected design will be made into pins that students may order for individual use and/or to trade with other state's students at the National Leadership Conference.

- Rules and Procedures**
1. Competitors in this event must be active members of HOSA in good standing in the category in which they are registered to compete (Secondary or Postsecondary/Collegiate).
  2. The pin design must be original art work of the HOSA member.
  3. The pin design must include the following:
    - a. Colorado theme (ex: winter/snow activities)
    - b. The year (date)
    - c. The name HOSA on the design
  4. The pin design must be identified with the member's name and school on the back of the design.
  5. The actual pin design must not exceed 5" by 5" and must not include more than 4 colors (in addition to black and white).
  6. Members are encouraged to remember that in pin design, the less clutter, the better.
  7. The pin design will be turned in at State Leadership Conference on-site registration.
  8. Designs will be placed on display at the State Leadership Conference for all members to view. State Officers may choose the top pin designs for viewing.
  9. HOSA voting delegates attending the State Leadership Conference shall select the winning design. The winning design will be announced at the Awards Session during the conference.
  10. The winning pin design may be available for purchase and trading at the National Leadership Conference in June.
  11. Competitors must be familiar with and adhere to the **"General Rules and Regulations of the National HOSA Competitive Events Program."**

**Required Personnel:**

1. One Coordinator

**Facilities, Equipment and Materials:**

1. Display area for pin designs.
2. Elections for pin design.
